Cheshire Alert in Hartford has made a good start and we are about to break the 300 mark for user's signed up to the system in the Hartford area. However this only represents a meagre 3.56% of the Hartford population meaning that people are missing out on updates and information from me your local PCSO (Police Community Support Officer).

I have set a target in Hartford to more than double our figures by the end of the year to 650 but I cannot do it without the help of YOU, the wonderful residents of our great community. So please tell your partners, children, neighbours, friends or anyone you know who lives in the Hartford area about the system and get them signed up. Together we can raise the profile of the system and help Hartford to feel more engaged with their local police. I will be hosting Cheshire Alert events in the area over the next 12 months and will be posting information about them on Alert. Thank you for taking the time to read this and hopefully we can achieve our target.

**Pupil Parliament**

It was our 10<sup>th</sup> Pupil Parliament last week. We welcomed a special visitor, Mr Stephen Laverick (School Governor) to our discussion.
