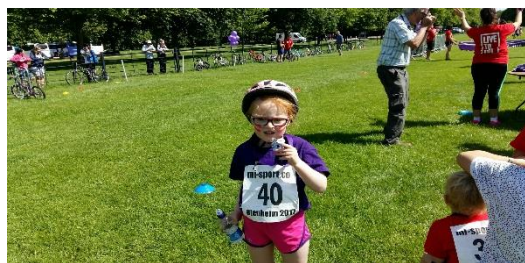
## Cake Sale Funds Raised and Expenditure
