Year 1 Phonics Screening Check July 2017

Phonics is a way of teaching children to read quickly and skilfully. The screening check is a quick and easy way of testing a child's phonic knowledge at the end of Year 1. The children read 40 words, some of them real and some of them nonsense. Any child who does not make the expected standard is re-tested at the end of Year 2. I'm extremely proud to be able to share our results over the last five years. These show the percentage of children passing the test:
