## **Healthy Living Week**

## **Morning Zumba and Golden Mile**

To celebrate Healthy Living Week, Mr Cairns and Mrs Dickenson led Zumba sessions on the playground at 8.45am for any of the children (and staff!) who wanted to join in. The playground has been buzzing with excitement and there have been some excellent moves on display! It was a lovely way to begin a very active set of days, with the rest of the children taking part in a golden mile before beginning their school day.

We have really enjoyed hearing all the positive feedback from parents, carers, and children – and seeing your videos and pictures – and we know how much everyone has enjoyed the Zumba in particular! These events take a lot of planning and organisation in order to run smoothly – a huge thanks goes to Mr Cairns and the SSOC for their care, attention, and impeccable organisational skills. I know everyone agrees that the week has been a huge success.

### Year 1 Visit to Reaseheath Mini Zoo

On Monday and Tuesday, 1JD and 1CW visited Reaseheath Mini Zoo to consolidate their learning from their Science topic on Animals. The children got to take part in a tour of the zoo, to play some games and learn some fun animal facts. They also took part in a workshop all about animal classification, testing their knowledge on herbivores, omnivores, and carnivores!
