Athletics

The indoor athletics team recently headed to Warrington and Vale Royal College for the first round of the Indoor Athletics competition. They competed in 12 races and a number of field events including long jump, triple jump, javelin, speed bounce, chest push and high jump. The children enjoyed competing against pupils from Charles Darwin, Hartford Manor, Winnington Park, Barnton and Whitegate. When the results were announced the children were delighted to hear that they had won and were going through to the next round. University of Chester Academy Northwich was the venue for the Vale Royal Finals. Winning schools from the surrounding areas were there, including Sandiway, Winsford High Street and Wincham. The children competed amazingly well and won again! They will now represent Vale Royal at the County Final in March. Well done to all the children involved.
