## **Pupil Parliament**

Last week Pupil Parliament shared their thoughts on our behaviour and rewards system. They were joined by Mrs Hughes, one of our Governors, the children shared with her the following.

### **Quotes**

With the old (behaviour) system we only had 4 chances, a reminder, then an amber card, red card, then letter home. This one gives you one more chance. On the old system you have to be on your best behaviour *all* of the time. With this system you have another chance to back you up if you forget. I prefer this one. Its good grounding as it prepares us for High School.

We have tokens: responsibility tokens, pride tokens, respect tokens – teachers can give you them if you show signs of these behaviours. The tokens get counted and put on a board and the target is 800, which the children thought was a fair amount to aim for, they felt a smaller number would be too easily achieved. Once we reach 800 we get to choose a class treat, as an example, we wore our pyjamas and made slime!

## **Remembrance**

During our first week back after the half term holiday, we will be marking the centenary of the end of the First World War. The children will all be making poppies and making wreaths which they will bring in to our own commemorative assembly. The children are invited to wear something red on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> November and bring in £1 which will be donated to the charity 'Help for Heroes.'


