CURRICULUM, LEARNING AND RESULTS

Our ambitious curriculum is coherently planned to offer our children a wide range of development opportunities designed to build confidence, independence and resilience. The broad range of opportunities our curriculum offers, includes learning outside the classroom and a commitment to No Outsiders, inclusion and diversity. These opportunities are designed to inspire all children and ensure they are equipped with the skills to not only make academic progress, but to build positive relationships, value each other and respect the rich diversity our world has to offer.

In Summer 2019 (schools most recently published data), our school outperformed in national tests, exceeding all national comparators. We achieved a 90% pass rate in Year 1 phonics screening and in Key Stage 1 and 2; Reading, Writing, Maths and SPAG were above the national expected level.

These results are testament to our children's hard work and commitment and also to our teacher's skills at securing the best possible outcomes for each individual.



SPORTS AND EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

We are extremely proud of the many sporting and extra-curricular opportunities we offer our children. In normal circumstances, we have over 10 after school clubs running each week, which we rotate each term to ensure continued interest. These range from a Theatre Group, Yoga, Football, Netball, Judo, Golf, Art, Dance, Science and Choir.

Our sporting achievements are amazing! We hold four prestigious School Games Platinum Awards, and are members of the Vale Royal School Sports Partnership, which gives our pupils the opportunity to take part in a range of different sports, with a number of local primary schools. Our dedicated Sports teacher ensures that healthy living and an active lifestyle is embedded in our school ethos.
