### Start to the School Day

Thank you for your support with our new timings for the start of the school day. The gates now open at 8.45am and close promptly at 8.55am. It has been very noticeable throughout school that this has had a significantly positive impact, with the children settled, focused and ready to learn by 9am.

#### **Attendance**

A reminder that pupils arriving at school after 8.55am will be classed as late and this will impact their attendance. Should your child need to attend a medical appointment (GP. Dentist, hospital) that can't be made outside of school hours you will need to supply proof of the appointment details to our office team.
